Family Prayer Group

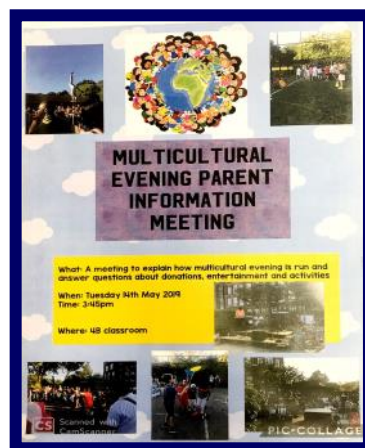
Family Prayer group continues on a Friday morning before school at 8:35 am. Currently we are praying the Stations of Light celebrating the Resurrection.
