Timings:

Give yourself plenty of time and arrive at least <u>30mins before your race starts</u> to register at your school desk and collect your running bib.

Registration Opens: 2:00pm
Welcome address: 2:15pm
Collective Warm-up: 2:25pm

- After the collective warm-up, children will be split into year groups and the race starts will be staggered every 15 minutes.
- Nursery and Reception will be directed to the start line with their parents/carers, while the other year groups will be directed to a colour group for games.
- 5min before the start of the race, each group will be called to the start line.
