The programme is a mixture of class learning and physical exercise delivered by the class teachers. It is separate to the PE lessons but is another way of promoting an active lifestyle. It is also aimed at getting the children to take part in The Battersea Park Junior Parkrun.

This 2km run for children takes place every Sunday in Battersea Park at 9am. All children are welcome to this wonderful weekly fun run. It's a great event for families.


